FORMAT & RULES

All teams are required to post a \$20 signup fee. Booth spaces will be assigned on the morning of the event. Spaces are 10x10 feet.

Each team is responsible for supplying all their needs, table, stove, cooking utensils, and ingredients for at least four to six (4-6) gallons of chowder.

You may make the chowder of your choice but we are looking for hearty winter soup. You may use cans of sauce or broth but no using cans of soup and saying it is your own. Ingredients may be chopped beforehand and brought in plastic bags but all cooking must be done at the Visitor Center on the day of the Cook-Off.

Teams may prepare and serve "munchies" if desired. This is not mandatory; however, it may help with the "Popular" vote.

Cooking will start at 8 am. Your soup must be ready by noon for the judges' tasting. The Chamber will provide tasting kits to the public. There will be a "Popular Vote" ticket in the kit, so be sure to have a container to be used to collect them.

Winners will be announced at 3:30pm. There will be an award for the "Popular Vote" and an award for the "Judges' Choice." An award will also be given for the "Best Decorated Booth," but the booth must be affiliated with your chowder, i.e. clam chowder might have a sea theme.

Please dress appropriately for the weather as the event is held outside, during rain, snow, or shine.
