EVENT RULES

STARTING CANDENCE:

"Timers ready, contestants ready, 3, 2, 1. GO!"  
Hotsaw - "Hands on the wood, 3, 2, 1 GO!"

- \*All events will start on GO unless specified in the event rules\*
- \*Chopping events time ends when the block is severed\*

Safety Equipment

- \*Chopping events will require foot protection\*
- \*140 cc and under & hot saw require leg protection.\*

**CHOPPING EVENTS:** Slab nails or band are required. At least 4 nails on chip side.

\*Standing Block and Underhand will have a time limit of 3 minutes.  
Springboard will have a time limit of 5 minutes.

Springboard will be limited to the first 12 competitors to sign up for the event. **Competitors unable to finish in the given time limits will receive a DNF.**

**100cc & UNDER MUFFLER SAW:** Hot start, open fuel. Either 1 or 2 cuts. Time starts when chips fly. **"ONLY ONE SAW WILL BE RUN ONCE PER CLASS, NO SHARING"**. No expansion chambers. Two-piece heads are okay. Air cleaner optional. **\*Cut out will result in no time.\***

**JACK AND JILL:** Factory Peg & Raker only. Man and woman.

**SINGLE BUCK:** Open saw.

**140cc & UNDER PRODUCTION HOTSAW:** Expansion chamber is okay, open fuel. Must have started life as a chainsaw. All other rules same as 6.0 class. **No Sharing of Saws! Requires leg protection.**

**SPEED AXE:** As many points as you can get in 30 seconds. Leading edge must stick to count. Double sickles don't count and throwing over the line will result in no points for that throw.

**OLE SALEM MEMORIAL AXE THROW:** **\*WINNER TAKES ALL\*** Previous jackpots have been \$1000.00 or more. First throw is practice, next 3 throws will count for score. Leading edge must stick to count. Double stick doesn't count and crossing the line while throwing will result in no score.

**UNLIMITED HOTSAW:** 1 cut, hot start on 30-32 inch log or cant. Single cylinder, must be able to carry under your own power and be able to pull start. Pull cord tether is required. Contestants can use their own tether. Contestants will have 60 seconds to warm up saws. **There will be no production hotsaws. Requires leg protection. \*Incomplete disc(s) or cutting over the 6-inch will result in DQ.\***
